As you enter your new home you will be asked to pay an ingoing contribution which secures the right to live in the village. The contribution will be partly refunded to you once you leave the village. On departure from the village you will pay a fee often called a Deferred Management Fee (DMF) or Exit Fee.

The DMF is calculated from the date of entry and is based on a clear and defined percentage of the ingoing contribution that is outlined in the Disclosure Document. The DMF is based on your length of stay.

At time of exit you will be refunded the ingoing contribution less the DMF.
